Micheline Dionne, FCIA, FSA, MAAA

Micheline Dionne, the first woman to be elected President of the Institute, is senior vice-president and chief actuary for RGA Canada, a life reinsurance company operating in Canada since 1992. In addition to being a Montreal-based member of the senior management team, she is also responsible for business development in Québec and the Maritimes, and developing new lines of business.

Ms Dionne is an actuarial science graduate of Université Laval (1977), a fellow of the Canadian Institute of Actuaries and Society of Actuaries (both 1982) and a Member of the American Academy of Actuaries (1995).

She has worked for a number of life insurance companies and consulting firms in Canada, mostly in the areas of product pricing, policyholder liability valuation, risk management and asset-liability management. She has been the Appointed Actuary for the Canadian operations of Metropolitan Life and RGA Canada.

A long-time CIA volunteer, Ms Dionne served with the Program Committee, Task Force on CIA Organization and Committee on Life Insurance Financial Reporting. Prior to her election as President-elect, she was a member of the Actuarial Standards Board and had twice served on the CIA Board of Directors.
