Subject: **Technical Amendments – Standards of Practice – Practice-Specific Standards for Public Personal Injury Compensation Plans, Part 5000 and Standards of Practice – Post-Employment Benefit Plans, Part 6000**

The Standards of Practice Editing Committee has proposed, and the Practice Standards of Council has approved with an effective date of May 1, 2006, revisions to the current Standards of Practice, Parts 5000 and 6000.

The changes are being released as the Final Standards and are attached hereto.

The amendments are not substantive and do not in any way change either the intent of the meaning of the Standards of Practice. The changes are made to take the first steps toward unity in style, format and punctuation of the Standards of Practice creating a consistency throughout.

In accordance with the Institute's policy for due process for technical changes to the Standards of Practice, these technical changes have been distributed to the various practice committees for their review and comment. Final approval is the responsibility of the Practice Standards Council and that was given at its meeting April 5, 2006.
